



COVID-19 SAFETY MEASURES

Considering the current evolution of the situation, we have decided to host our conferences as scheduled. However, even more than before, we pay extreme attention to the safety and wellbeing of our attendees and employees. Therefore, we have designed a protocol based on the advice and safety rules from the World Health Organization (WHO), as well as the national and local authorities. We also work in close collaboration with all hotels and conference venues we partner with to ensure complete and efficient implementation of these measures.

This lists the main safety precautions that we will be taking onsite to ensure the smooth and safe operation of all our events for all our attendees, and will be implemented until further notice.

We kindly ask you to read them carefully.



Temperature-screening

All participants and staff will be screened at the registration desk. If you are denied entry due to temperature, you will be provided with a credit note to attend any of our future events without any limitation of time



Social distancing

1 meter (3 feet) distance will be enforced in conference rooms.



Increased cleaning

Special attention and cleaning measures will be implemented across all high-volume touchpoints, e.g. handrails, WCs, public touchscreens, etc., in addition to a microphone change protocol for all speakers



Sanitizing

Availability of alcohol-based hand sanitizers and disinfection materials for public use. Protecting yourself and others. Availability of masks covering the nose and mouth as well as the requirement to wear them on conference premises.



Exhibiting protection measures

Advice to exhibitors on implementing effective cleaning and disinfection of stands. Exhibitors will be assisted to ensure their products and stations have been sanitized regularly across each day



Assisting and training

Awareness and training to all staff on standard personal preventative measures, e.g. personal hygiene, frequency of use of sanitizing products, etc.

We also call to everyone's responsibility and willingness to protect themselves and others by taking simple precautions, such as regularly and thoroughly cleaning hands with an alcohol-based hand rub or washing them with soap and water, maintaining social distancing, avoiding going to crowded places, following good respiratory hygiene, etc.

We keep monitoring the updates on health, safety recommendations and rules, and might change or add measures accordingly.

We will be constantly updating you on any changes in the upcoming months, but we also advise you to regularly check our webpage to make sure you do not miss anything. We are looking forward to welcoming you soon.
